

2027 AID Post Graduate Case Discussion in Dermatology Course

Dear Colleagues, In 2027 the Institute will run an Interactive case discussion course where each module will be made up of 10 cases that we will discuss. The cases will be a mixture of the common and the rare presentations of skin disease. We will discuss differential diagnoses and investigations and treatment for each case. The purpose is to keep you up to speed in the approach we used in the Membership course and to introduce any new conditions or treatments in the commoner skin diseases. There is not a specific book to consult but the cases will be presented through the www.skincanceratlas.blogspot.com website we used last year in the 2026 Regional Dermatology Course.

The webinars will again be every 2 weeks on a Thursday night at 8.15 PM my time starting early Feb. The course will run over 2 Semesters of 14 weeks each semester. There will be no exams.

Looking at the cases beforehand and attending the webinars will cover most of your CPD requirements for 2027. Submitting a few cases and attending the Alumni webinars held on the Alternate Thursday nights will cover your Cat 2 and 3 requirements. The discussion of these cases can also be claimed as Cat 2 points if you have perused the cases earlier.
